**"AN ACT CONCERNING BAKERIES AND FOOD
MANUFACTURING ESTABLISHMENTS."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 21a-151 of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

5 For the purposes of this chapter and section 3 of this act:

6 (1) "Bakery" means a building or part of a building [wherein is
7 carried on the production of] where bread, cakes, doughnuts, crullers,
8 pies, cookies, crackers, spaghetti, macaroni or other food products are
9 made, either wholly or in part of flour or meal, [and including all]
10 including frozen or canned baked goods. [All restaurants, hotels,
11 private institutions, home bakeries, establishments operating
12 doughnut-frying equipment and other similar places, offering their
13 products for sale, shall be included.] "Bakery" includes, but is not

14 limited to, any restaurant, hotel, private institution, home bakery,
15 establishment operating doughnut-frying equipment or other similar
16 place that offers such food products for sale.

17 (2) "Food manufacturing establishment" means a building or part of
18 a building where food is prepared for sale to other establishments for
19 human consumption. For purposes of this subdivision, "prepared"
20 means a process of canning, cooking, freezing, [dehydration or
21 milling] dehydrating, milling, repacking or cutting. Premises [which]
22 that are used solely for the retail sale or storage of prepackaged food,
23 and facilities, as described in sections 21a-24a and 22-6r [,] and
24 chapters 417, 419a, 422, 423, 430, 431 and 491, shall not be considered
25 food manufacturing establishments.

26 (3) "Food warehouse" means a building or part of a building where
27 food is stored for wholesale distribution, provided such building or
28 part of such building is used primarily for the importation, storage or
29 distribution of packaged food and not for other activities for which a
30 license is required pursuant to section 21a-152, as amended by this act.
31 Premises licensed pursuant to said section and facilities, as described
32 in sections 21a-24a and 22-6r and chapters 417, 419a, 422, 423, 430, 431
33 and 491, shall not be considered food warehouses.

34 [(3)] (4) "Packaged food" means standard or random weight or
35 volume packages of food commodities that are enclosed in a container
36 or wrapped in any manner in advance of wholesale or retail sale, such
37 that the food commodities cannot be added to or subtracted from the
38 package or wrapping without breaking or tearing the wrapping,
39 container or seals on the wrapping or container.

40 Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 21a-152 of the general statutes is
41 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
42 *passage*):

43 (a) Each bakery and food manufacturing establishment shall be
44 designed, constructed and operated as the Commissioner of Consumer

45 Protection directs pursuant to this chapter and chapter 418.

46 Sec. 3. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) No person, firm or corporation
 47 shall operate a food warehouse without having obtained a certificate of
 48 registration from the Commissioner of Consumer Protection.
 49 Application for a certificate of registration shall be on forms prescribed
 50 by the commissioner. The commissioner shall issue a certificate of
 51 registration to an applicant who has completed such forms to the
 52 satisfaction of the commissioner and has paid the registration fee. A
 53 certificate of registration shall be valid for one year and the fee for such
 54 certificate of registration shall be twenty dollars."
