"AN ACT CONCERNING POST-ELECTION AUDITS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) The Secretary of the State shall
4 develop a pilot program to train registrars of voters, town clerks and
5 any other town election official who may handle, distribute or process
6 an absentee ballot on the rules or procedures for handling, distributing
7 and processing such ballots in accordance with the provisions of
8 chapter 145 of the general statutes. The Secretary shall provide such
9 training for each regular election, as defined pursuant to section 9-1 of
10 the general statutes, prior to any primary associated with such
11 election, held in 2014 or 2015, to such election officials from five towns
12 determined by the Secretary, provided three such towns shall be the
13 three towns with the largest population, one such town shall be a town
14 with a population greater than forty thousand, but less than seventy
15 thousand, and one such town shall be a town with a population less
16 than ten thousand. Not later than April 1, 2014, the Secretary shall

17 report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general
18 statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
19 having cognizance of matters relating to elections concerning such
20 program and any recommendations for expansion or continuation of
21 such program."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
