"AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO ENERGY STATUTES."

1 Strike subsection (c) of section (4) and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "(c) The council shall undertake all requisite efforts to obtain
4 nonprofit, tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
5 Revenue Code of 1986, or any subsequent corresponding internal
6 revenue code of the United States, as amended from time to time. The
7 council shall solicit and accept funds, on behalf of the Recycle CT
8 Foundation, Inc., to be used for the purpose of making grants to
9 programs that are intended to increase the rate of recycling and reuse
10 of solid waste materials in the state. The council shall establish criteria
11 and procedures for the award of such grants, provided recipients of
12 such grants may include: Nonprofit organizations, civic and
13 community groups, schools, public agencies, including, but not limited
14 to, trash museums, municipalities, regional entities that represent

15 municipalities or organizations in the private sector. Any person
16 seeking the award of such grant shall file an application with the
17 council on a form as prescribed by the council."
