"AN ACT CONCERNING TOBACCO BARS."

- Strike lines 31 to 58, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:
- "(2) This section shall not apply to (A) correctional facilities; (B) 3 designated smoking areas in psychiatric facilities; (C) public housing 4 5 projects, as defined in subsection (b) of section 21a-278a; (D) any 6 classroom where demonstration smoking is taking place as part of a 7 medical or scientific experiment or lesson; (E) smoking rooms 8 provided by employers for employees, pursuant to section 31-40q; (F) 9 notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph (E) of subdivision (1) 10 of this subsection, the outdoor portion of the premises of any permittee 11 listed in subparagraph (E) of subdivision (1) of this subsection, 12 provided, in the case of any seating area maintained for the service of 13 food, at least seventy-five per cent of the outdoor seating capacity is an area in which smoking is prohibited and which is clearly designated 14 15 with written signage as a nonsmoking area, except that any temporary

16 seating area established for special events and not used on a regular 17 basis shall not be subject to the smoking prohibition or signage 18 requirements of this subparagraph; (G) any medical research site 19 where smoking is integral to the research being conducted; or (H) any 20 tobacco bar, provided [no tobacco bar shall expand in size or change its 21 location from its size or location as of December 31, 2002 a tobacco bar 22 that first begins operating on or after October 1, 2019, shall (i) be 23 located in a stand-alone building, (ii) have a walk-in humidor on the 24 premises, (iii) not be located within a three-mile radius of any existing 25 tobacco bar, unless allowed pursuant to municipal zoning, or (iv) if 26 such tobacco bar is connected to another building, use its own heating, 27 ventilation or air conditioning system to prevent the comingling of air. 28 For purposes of this subdivision, "outdoor" means an area which has 29 no roof or other ceiling enclosure, "tobacco bar" means an 30 establishment with a permit for the sale of alcoholic liquor to 31 consumers issued pursuant to chapter 545 that, (I) in the calendar year 32 ending December 31, 2002, generated ten per cent or more of its total 33 annual gross income from the on-site sale of tobacco products and the 34 rental of on-site humidors, or (II) for any tobacco bar that first begins 35 operating on or after October 1, 2019, generates fifty-one per cent or 36 more of its total annual gross income in a calendar year from the on-37 site sale of tobacco products and the rental of on-site humidors, and 38 "tobacco product" means any substance that contains tobacco, 39 including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco or 40 chewing tobacco. "

Strike lines 134 to 167, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

"(2) This section shall not apply to (A) correctional facilities; (B) designated smoking areas in psychiatric facilities; (C) public housing projects, as defined in subsection (b) of section 21a-278a; (D) any classroom where a demonstration of the use of an electronic nicotine delivery system or vapor product is taking place as part of a medical or scientific experiment or lesson; (E) any medical research site where the use of an electronic nicotine delivery system or vapor product is

integral to the research being conducted; (F) establishments without a permit for the sale of alcoholic liquor that sell electronic nicotine delivery systems, vapor products or liquid nicotine containers on-site and allow their customers to use such systems, products or containers on-site; (G) smoking rooms provided by employers for employees, pursuant to section 31-40q; (H) notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph (E) of subdivision (1) of this subsection, the outdoor portion of the premises of any permittee listed in subparagraph (E) of subdivision (1) of this subsection, provided, in the case of any seating area maintained for the service of food, at least seventy-five per cent of the outdoor seating capacity is an area in which smoking is prohibited and which is clearly designated with written signage as a nonsmoking area, except that any temporary seating area established for special events and not used on a regular basis shall not be subject to the prohibition on the use of an electronic nicotine delivery system or vapor product or the signage requirements of this subparagraph; or (I) any tobacco bar, provided [no tobacco bar shall expand in size or change its location from its size or location as of October 1, 2015] a tobacco bar that first begins operating on or after October 1, 2019, shall (i) be located in a stand-alone building, (ii) have a walk-in humidor on the premises, (iii) not be located within a three-mile radius of any existing tobacco bar, unless allowed pursuant to municipal zoning, or (iv) if such tobacco bar is connected to another building, use its own heating, ventilation or air conditioning system to prevent the comingling of air.

For purposes of this subdivision, "outdoor" means an area which has no roof or other ceiling enclosure, "tobacco bar" means an establishment with a permit for the sale of alcoholic liquor to consumers issued pursuant to chapter 545 that, (I) in the calendar year ending December 31, 2015, generated ten per cent or more of its total annual gross income from the on-site sale of tobacco products and the rental of on-site humidors, or (II) for any tobacco bar that first begins operating on or after October 1, 2019, generates fifty-one per cent or more of its total annual gross income in a calendar year from the on-
