"AN ACT CONCERNING COVID-19 RELIEF FOR SMALL BUSINESSES AND REQUIRING FEDERAL REGULATORY ANALYSIS FOR PROPOSED STATE REGULATIONS."

- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
- 2 following in lieu thereof:
- 3 "Section 1. Section 12-412 of the general statutes is amended by
- 4 adding subdivision (125) as follows (Effective July 1, 2021, and applicable
- 5 to sales occurring on or after July 1, 2021):
- 6 (NEW) (125) (A) On and after July 1, 2021, and prior to July 1, 2023,
- 7 sales to, and the storage, use or other consumption of personal
- 8 protective equipment by, a small business for use by such business.
- 9 (B) To qualify for such exemption, each purchaser of personal 10 protective equipment shall present a certificate to the retailer, in such
- 11 form as the commissioner may prescribe, certifying that the purchaser
- 12 is a small business and is purchasing such personal protective

13 equipment for its business. The purchaser of the personal protective

- 14 equipment shall be liable for the tax otherwise imposed if the certificate
- is improperly provided to the seller, and any person who wilfully
- delivers a certificate that is known to be fraudulent or false in any
- 17 material matter to a seller shall, in addition to any other penalty
- 18 provided by law, be guilty of a class D felony.
- 19 (C) As used in this subdivision:
- 20 (i) "COVID-19" means the respiratory disease designated by the
- 21 World Health Organization on February 11, 2020, as coronavirus 2019,
- 22 and any related mutation thereof recognized by the World Health
- 23 Organization as a communicable respiratory disease;
- 24 (ii) "Personal protective equipment" means (I) specialized clothing or
- 25 equipment worn by an employee for protection against infectious
- 26 disease and materials, including, but not limited to, protective
- 27 equipment for the eyes, face, head and extremities, protective clothing
- 28 and protective shields and barriers, and (II) disinfecting products
- 29 approved for use against COVID-19 by the National Centers for Disease
- 30 Control and Prevention; and
- 31 (iii) "Small business" means a corporation, limited liability company
- 32 partnership, sole proprietorship or individual, operating a business for
- 33 profit, which employs one hundred or fewer full-time employees,
- 34 including employees employed in any subsidiary or affiliated
- 35 corporation."
