- 4 Governor shall not issue an executive order that requires any person to
- 5 produce evidence of having obtained a COVID-19 vaccination in order
- 6 to: (1) Continue or secure such person's employment with an agency or
- 7 department of the state, (2) obtain or continue to receive any benefit
- 8 issued by the state, or (3) access any building owned, leased or
- 9 otherwise under the control of the state."
