31 agencies] a contracting agency of the state, as defined in section 4e-35,
32 as amended by this act, on or after June 1, 2010, and all contracts
33 solicited or entered into by a contracting agency that is a quasi-public
34 agency on or after July 1, 2022, and (2) section 4e-16, as amended by this
35 act, shall apply to all contracts solicited or entered into by a contracting
36 agency of the state, as defined in section 4e-35, as amended by this act,
37 on or after June 1, 2010.
- 38 (b) Except as otherwise provided, the provisions of sections 4e-16 to

39 4e-47, inclusive, as amended by this act, shall apply to every
40 expenditure of public funds by any [state] contracting agency,
41 irrespective of their source, involving any state or quasi-public
42 contracting and procurement processes, including, but not limited to,
43 leasing and property transfers, purchasing or leasing of supplies,
44 materials or equipment, consultant or consultant services, personal
45 service agreements, purchase of service agreements or privatization
46 contracts, as defined in section 4e-1, as amended by this act, and,
47 relating to contracts for the construction, reconstruction, alteration,
48 remodeling, repair or demolition of any public building, bridge or road,
49 provided the provisions of section 4e-16, as amended by this act, or
50 other provisions of this chapter involving privatization contracts shall
51 only apply to contracting agencies of the state, as defined in section 4e-
52 35, as amended by this act.

53 (c) Nothing in sections 4e-16 to 4e-47, inclusive, as amended by this
54 act, shall be construed to require the application of procurement statutes
55 or regulations to a procurement that involves the expenditure of federal
56 assistance or federal contract funds if federal law provides procurement
57 procedures applicable to the expenditure of such funds, to the extent
58 such federal procedures are inconsistent with state procurement
59 statutes or regulations."
