**"AN ACT CONCERNING PERSONAL DATA PRIVACY AND ONLINE MONITORING."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2022*) For the purposes of the  
4 Children's Online Privacy Protection Act, 15 USC 6501 et seq., as  
5 amended from time to time, in the state of Connecticut, "child" means  
6 an individual under the age of sixteen.

7 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2022*) (a) As used in this section,  
8 the terms "operator", "web site or online service directed to children",  
9 "parent" and "personal information" have the same meaning as  
10 provided in the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act, 15 USC 6501  
11 et seq., as amended from time to time.

12 (b) On and after October 1, 2022, not later than ten days after receipt

13 of a request by a parent, an operator shall delete the account of such  
14 parent's child, as defined in section 501 of this act, or cease the further  
15 use or maintenance in retrievable form, or future online collection, of  
16 personal information collected from such child, on any of the operator's  
17 web sites or online services directed to children. Each operator shall  
18 provide a reasonable, accessible and verifiable means by which a parent  
19 can make such request to the operator."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
