5 (a) No person shall be eligible for office of justice or
6 judge of any court unless the person is an elector of the state
7 and resides in the territorial jurisdiction of the court. No
8 justice or judge shall serve after attaining the age of seventy
9 years except upon temporary assignment or to complete a term,
10 one-half of which has been served. However, if a justice of the
11 supreme court attains the age of seventy years on or after the
12 date one year before the term of the governor expires, that
13 justice shall remain in office until the governor whose term
14 commences after the expiration of the term of governor in office

21 REPLACEMENT OF JUSTICES; TERM LIMITS FOR APPELLATE COURTS.-

22 Proposing an amendment to require a Supreme Court justice who
23 attains mandatory retirement during the last year of a
24 Governor's term be replaced by the next Governor; limits the
25 terms of Supreme Court justices and judges of the district
26 courts of appeal, who currently serve unlimited 6-year terms, if
27 retained, until mandatory retirement. The amendment limits them
28 to two full terms, not counting partial ones. Term limits do not
29 apply to current justices and judges.
