- 22 (5) U.S. Representative from Florida, or
- 23 (6) U.S. Senator from Florida

24 if, by the end of the current term of office, the person will
25 have served (or, but for resignation, would have served) in that
26 office for eight consecutive years.

27 (c) No person who has served as a Florida representative
28 may appear on the ballot for election to the office of Florida
29 senator until two years after expiration of the person's last
