The purpose of this measure is to establish and appropriate funds for a New Waste Management Solution Pilot Project to be conducted by the University of Hawaii Water Resources Research Center to:

- (1) Review and demonstrate new toilet and sewage treatment technologies at different scales and in different locations across the State; and
- (2) Examine and implement a range of toilet and sewage treatment technologies and examine options for community-scale solutions, as appropriate.
