1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3424 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 3424 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Department of Veterans' Affairs Act is 4 5 amended by adding Section 6 as follows: 6 (20 ILCS 2805/6 new) 7 Sec. 6. Veterans' Disability Compensation Task Force. (a) The Veterans' Disability Compensation Task Force is 8 created to assess ways the State of Illinois can improve the 9 10 rate at which disability compensation claims are approved by the federal government and correct the disparity between the 11 12 U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs' approval of disability 13 compensation for Illinois veterans and that which is approved 14 for veterans in other states. 15 (b) The Task Force shall consist of the chair and minority

spokesperson of the Veterans' Affairs Committee in the House of

- 1 Representatives, the chair and minority spokesperson of the
- Veterans Affairs Committee in the Senate, and 15 members 2
- appointed by the chair of the Veterans' Affairs Committee in 3
- 4 the House of Representatives and the chair of the Veterans
- 5 Affairs Committee in the Senate. Those appointed to the Task
- 6 Force shall be members of different Illinois counties' Veterans
- Assistance Commissions, Veteran Service Officers, and VITAS 7
- 8 officials.
- 9 (c) Task Force members shall serve without compensation but
- 10 may be reimbursed for any travel expenses incurred in attending
- 11 meetings. Within 60 days of the effective date of this
- amendatory Act of the 101st General Assembly, the Task Force 12
- 13 shall meet, and thereafter shall meet at least quarterly.
- 14 (d) The Department of Veterans' Affairs shall provide
- 15 administrative and other support to the Task Force.
- 16 (e) The Task Force shall prepare a report that summarizes
- its work and makes recommendations resulting from its study. 17
- The Task Force shall submit the report of its findings and any 18
- 19 recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or
- 20 before July 1, 2020.
- 21 (f) This Section is repealed on July 1, 2021.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 22
- 23 becoming law.".
