1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 109 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 109 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Authorized Electronic Monitoring in 4 5 Long-Term Care Facilities Act is amended by changing Sections 5 and 10 as follows: 6 7 (210 ILCS 32/5) Sec. 5. Definitions. As used in this Act: 8 "Authorized electronic monitoring" means the placement and 9 use of an electronic monitoring device by a resident in his or 10 her room in accordance with this Act. 11 "Department" means the Department of Public Health. 12 13 "Electronic monitoring device" means a surveillance 14 instrument with a fixed position video camera or an audio 15 recording device, or a combination thereof, that is installed

in a resident's room under the provisions of this Act and

- broadcasts or records activity or sounds occurring in the room. 1
- 2 "Facility" means an intermediate care facility for the
- 3 developmentally disabled licensed under the ID/DD Community
- 4 Care Act that has 30 beds or more, a facility licensed under
- 5 the MC/DD Act, or a long-term care facility licensed under the
- Nursing Home Care Act, or a facility that provides housing to 6
- individuals with dementia, as defined in Section 3 of the 7
- 8 Alzheimer's Disease Assistance Act.
- 9 "Resident" means a person residing in a facility.
- 10 "Resident's representative" has the meaning given to that
- 11 term in (1) Section 1-123 of the Nursing Home Care Act if the
- resident resides in a facility licensed under the Nursing Home 12
- 13 Care Act, (2) Section 1-123 of the ID/DD Community Care Act if
- 14 the resident resides in a facility licensed under the ID/DD
- 15 Community Care Act, or (3) Section 1-123 of the MC/DD Act if
- 16 the resident resides in a facility licensed under the MC/DD
- 17 Act.

- 21 (a) A resident shall be permitted to conduct authorized
- 22 electronic monitoring of the resident's room through the use of
- electronic monitoring devices placed in the room pursuant to 23

- 25 (b) Nothing in this Act shall be construed to allow the use

- 3 (c) A facility that houses dementia residents may allow
- electronic monitoring devices only in rooms: 4

- dedicated to dementia care. 8
