1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1236 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 1236, AS AMENDED, with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 3 4 1, on page 4, by replacing lines 1 through 20 with the 5 following: "(a) As used in this Section, "familial relationship" means 6 an individual's father, mother, son, daughter, brother, 7 sister, uncle, aunt, great aunt, great uncle, first cousin, 8 nephew, niece, husband, wife, grandfather, grandmother, 9 grandson, granddaughter, father-in-law, mother-in-law, 10 son-in-law, daughter-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, 11 stepfather, stepmother, stepson, stepdaughter, stepbrother, 12 13 stepsister, half-brother, half-sister, and the father, mother, 14 grandfather, or grandmother of the individual's spouse and the 15 individual's fiance or fiancee. (b) A county may deny, suspend, or terminate the 16

eligibility of a person, firm, corporation, association,

- agency, institution, or other legal entity to participate as a 1 2 vendor of goods or services to the county if the vendor, for contracts greater than \$30,000, fails to disclose to the county 3 4 a familial relationship between a county elected official or 5 county department director and any of the following individuals who have the authority to act on behalf of and with the power 6 to bind the respective person, firm, corporation, association, 7 agency, institution, or other legal entity: a corporate 8 9 officer; a member of the corporate board of directors; a 10 limited liability company manager; a member with management 11 authority of a limited liability company; or a partner of a 12 partnership.
 - (c) If a person, firm, corporation, association, agency, institution, or other legal entity seeking to contract with the county has a familial relationship required to be disclosed under subsection (b), then the contract may be approved or renewed by roll call vote of the county board following a recitation of the name of the county official and the nature of the familial relationship being disclosed."; and
