AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2133 1 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 2133 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding Section 4 5 1A-17 as follows: (10 ILCS 5/1A-17 new)6 7 Sec. 1A-17. Grace period. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code to the contrary, beginning January 1, 2005, an election authority may establish procedures, in 9 accordance with rules adopted by the State Board of Elections, 10 for the <u>registration of voters during the period from the close</u> 11 of registration for a primary or election and until the 14th 12 day before the primary or election. During this grace period, 1.3 an unregistered qualified elector may register to vote in 14 person in the office of the election authority or at a voter 15 16 registration location specifically designated for this purpose by the election authority of the jurisdiction in which the 17 applicant resides. A registered voter may submit a change of 18 address form during this period as well. The election authority 19 shall register that individual in the manner provided by law. 20 The State Board of Elections shall adopt necessary rules 21 for election authorities in the development of procedures under 22 this Section.".
