15	with resulting physical harm, pain,	or mental anguish or (ii)
16	willful deprivation by a person,	including a caregiver, of
17	goods or services that are necessary to avoid physical harm,	
18	mental anguish, or mental illness.	
19	"Neglect" means the failure to	provide for oneself the
20	goods or services that are necessar	ry to avoid physical harm,
21	mental anguish, or mental illness or the failure of a caregiver	
22	to provide these goods and services.	'; and
23	on page 8, by replacing lines 17 thro	ough 19 with the following:

"(4) a regional long term care ombudsman program under

- 2 purpose of securing background checks on all paid and volunteer
- ombudsmen.". 3
