1	Page 4, line 42, after "8." insert "(a)".
2	Page 5, after line 2, begin a new paragraph and insert:
3	"(b) This chapter does not apply to a document to which
4	IC 27-1-44 applies.
5	SECTION 2. IC 27-1-44 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
6	A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
7	1, 2014]:
8	Chapter 44. Electronic Posting of Documents
9	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "property and casualty
10	insurance" means one (1) or more of the types of insurance
11	described in IC 27-1-5-1, Class 2 and Class 3.
12	Sec. 2. A standard property and casualty insurance policy or
13	endorsement that does not contain personally identifiable
14	information may be:
15	(1) mailed or electronically delivered (as provided in
16	IC 27-1-43) to the insured; or
17	(2) posted on the insurer's Internet web site.
18	Sec. 3. An insurer that elects to post a property and casualty
19	insurance policy or endorsement on the insurer's Internet web site
20	under section 2 of this chapter shall comply with all the following:
21	(1) The policy or endorsement must remain accessible as long
22	as the policy is in force.

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1	(2) After the expiration of the policy or endorsement, the
2	insurer shall:
3	(A) archive the expired policy or endorsement for at leas
4	five (5) years; and
5	(B) make the expired policy or endorsement available upor
6	request.
7	(3) The policy or endorsement must be posted in a manner
8	that enables the insured to print and save the policy of
9	endorsement using programs or applications that are widely
10	available on the Internet and free of charge.
11	(4) The insurer provides to the insured the following
12	information in, or in addition to, each declaration page
13	provided at issuance and each renewal of the policy of
14	endorsement:
15	(A) A description of the specific policy or endorsemen
16	forms purchased by the insured.
17	(B) A method by which the insured may obtain, upon
18	request and without charge, a paper copy of the policy of
19	endorsement.
20	(C) The Internet web site address at which the policy of
21	endorsement is posted.
22	(5) The insurer provides written or electronic notice, in the
23	format preferred by the insured, of the following:
24	(A) Any change to the policy or endorsement form.
25	(B) The insured's right to obtain, upon request and withou
26	charge:
27	(i) a paper copy of the change to the policy of
28	endorsement form; and
29	(ii) the Internet web site address at which the policy or
30	endorsement is posted.".
