

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1061 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 2, line 18, after "if" insert ":
2	(1) the dental hygienist has completed at least three (3) years
3	of active practice as a dental hygienist under the direct
4	supervision of a licensed dentist;
5	(2)".
6	Page 2, line 18, after "has" insert ":
7	(A) provided the patient with a comprehensive oral
8	examination; and
9	(B) issued a written prescription for the care to be
10	provided;
11	within the previous forty-five (45) days; and
12	(3) the patient has a current medical history on file.".
13	Page 2, line 18, strike "examined the".
14	Page 2, strike lines 19 through 20.
15	Page 2, delete lines 21 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
16	insert:
17	"SECTION 2. IC 25-13-1-10, AS AMENDED BY P.L.134-2008,
18	SECTION 20, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
19	JULY 1, 2014]: Sec. 10. (a) A licensed dental hygienist may practice
20	dental hygiene in Indiana in the following:
21	(1) A dental office or clinical setting except as described in
22	subdivisions (3) through (5), where the dental hygienist is
23	practicing under the direct supervision or prescriptive
24	supervision of a legally practicing dentist.
25	(2) A dental school or dental hygiene school to teach and
26	demonstrate the practice of dental hygiene if direct supervision by
27	a licensed dentist is provided for training on providing local

1	anesthetics by injection.
2	(3) The dental clinic of any public, parochial, or private school or
3	other institution supported by public or private funds in which the
4	licensee is employed by the state department of health or any
5	county or city board of health or board of education or schoo
6	trustee or parochial authority or the governing body of any private
7	school where the dental hygienist is practicing under the direct or
8	prescriptive supervision of a licensed dentist.
9	(4) The dental clinic of a bona fide hospital, sanitarium, or
10	charitable institution duly established and being operated under
11	the laws of Indiana in which the licensee is employed by the
12	directors or governing board of such hospital, sanitarium, or
13	institution. However, such practice must be under the direct or
14	prescriptive supervision at all times of a licensed dentist who is
15	a staff member of the hospital or sanitarium or a member of the
16	governing board of the institution.
17	(5) A:
18	(A) fixed charitable dental care clinic;
19	(B) public health setting; or
20	(C) correctional institution;
21	that has been approved by the board and where the denta
22	hygienist is under the direct or prescriptive supervision of a
23	licensed dentist.
24	(b) A licensed dental hygienist may provide without supervision the
25	following:
26	(1) Dental hygiene instruction and in-service training withou
27	restriction on location.
28	(2) Screening and referrals for any person in a public health
29	setting.
30	(c) A dental hygienist may not use a laser to provide treatment
31	to a patient.
32	(d) The board shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to implement
33	this section.
34	(e) Before October 1, 2017, the board, with assistance from the
35	professional licensing agency, shall report to the legislative counci
36	in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 on the effectiveness of the
37	prescriptive supervision laws and rules and any changes that are
38	needed in the law concerning prescriptive supervision. This
39	subsection expires December 31, 2017.".
