1	Delete the title and insert the following:
2	A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
3	human services and to make an appropriation.
4	Page 8, between lines 25 and 26, begin a new paragraph and insert:
5	"Sec. 21. The division shall coordinate with community mental
6	health centers (as defined in IC 12-7-2-38) to provide to individuals
7	who test positive under this chapter, at no cost to the individuals,
8	drug abuse treatment at the community mental health centers.
9	Sec. 22. (a) The special drug testing litigation defense fund is
10	established for the purpose of providing reimbursement of the
11	costs and expenses incurred by the attorney general in defending
12	the constitutionality of actions taken in the 2014 session of the
13	general assembly in the passage of this chapter.
14	(b) The fund must be used to defend the constitutionality of
15	actions taken in the 2014 session of the general assembly in the
16	passage of this chapter.
17	(c) The fund shall be administered by the treasurer of state.
18	(d) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not
19	currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same
20	manner as other public money may be invested. Interest that
21	accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.
22	(e) The expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from
