MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1351 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:
- 2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
- 3 human services and to make an appropriation.
- 4 Page 8, between lines 25 and 26, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 5 **"Sec. 21. The division shall coordinate with community mental**
- 6 **health centers (as defined in IC 12-7-2-38) to provide to individuals**
- 7 **who test positive under this chapter, at no cost to the individuals,**
- 8 **drug abuse treatment at the community mental health centers.**
- 9 **Sec. 22. (a) The special drug testing litigation defense fund is**
- 10 **established for the purpose of providing reimbursement of the**
- 11 **costs and expenses incurred by the attorney general in defending**
- 12 **the constitutionality of actions taken in the 2014 session of the**
- 13 **general assembly in the passage of this chapter.**
- 14 **(b) The fund must be used to defend the constitutionality of**
- 15 **actions taken in the 2014 session of the general assembly in the**
- 16 **passage of this chapter.**
- 17 **(c) The fund shall be administered by the treasurer of state.**
- 18 **(d) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not**
- 19 **currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same**
- 20 **manner as other public money may be invested. Interest that**
- 21 **accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.**
- 22 **(e) The expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from**

1 money in the fund.

2 (f) Money to be deposited into the fund consists of the following:

3 (1) Appropriations made by the general assembly.

4 (2) Donations, gifts, or grants made by persons for carrying
5 out the purposes of the fund.

6 (g) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not
7 revert to the state general fund. Money in the fund is continually
8 appropriated.

9 (h) If judgment is rendered in favor of the plaintiff in a civil
10 action contesting the constitutionality of the general assembly
11 described in subsection (b), the court shall order the following:

12 (1) The money in the fund shall be used to pay damages
13 awarded to a successful plaintiff.

14 (2) The attorney general shall provide an accounting of funds
15 expended in defending the constitutionality of actions
16 described in subsection (b)."

17 Page 8, line 26, delete "21." and insert "23."

18 Page 9, between lines 16 and 17, begin a new paragraph and insert:

19 "SECTION 9. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014] (a) As used in this
20 SECTION, "legislative council" refers to the legislative council
21 established by IC 2-5-1.1-1.

22 (b) The general assembly urges the legislative council to assign
23 to a study committee during the 2014 legislative interim the task of
24 studying:

25 (1) access to nutritional foods in Indiana; and

26 (2) challenges relating to accessing nutritional foods in
27 Indiana.

28 (c) If a study committee is assigned the task described in
29 subsection (b), the study committee shall issue to the legislative
30 council a final report containing the study committee's findings
31 and recommendations, including any recommended legislation
32 concerning the topics, in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 not
33 later than November 1, 2014.

34 (d) This SECTION expires January 1, 2015.

35 SECTION 10. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014] (a) There is
36 appropriated to the special drug testing litigation fund established
37 by IC 12-14-5.4-22, as added by this act, for the state fiscal year
38 beginning July 1, 2014, five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000)
39 from the state general fund for its use in carrying out the purposes

- 1 **of the fund.**
- 2 **(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2015."**
- 3 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
