MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1186 be amended to read as follows:

1	1 age 6, between fines 2 and 3, begin a new paragraph and fiscit.
2	"SECTION 5. IC 22-4-13-5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
3	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
4	1,2015]: Sec. 5. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, the department
5	shall waive an individual's liability for repayment of benefits that
6	were paid to an individual not entitled to receive the benefits if:
7	(1) the individual received the benefits after July 1, 2011;
8	(2) the individual received the benefits without fault of the
9	individual; and
0	(3) the individual was not entitled to receive the benefits solely
1	as the result of changes in the unemployment insurance law
2	made by HEA 1450-2011 (P.L.2-2011).
3	(b) If an individual has repaid all or a part of an overpayment
4	that is waived under subsection (a), the department shall refund to
5	the individual all amounts paid to reimburse the department for
6	the benefits for which repayment is waived.

1	(c) Benefits for which repayment is waived under subsection (a)
2	shall be charged to the fund and not to:
3	(1) the experience account of any employer; or
4	(2) an employer making payments in lieu of contributions.".
