I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 295 be amended to read as follows:

1	Delete the title and insert the following:
2	A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
3	military and veterans.
4	Page 4, between lines 15 and 16, begin a new line block indented
5	and insert:
6	"(12) To ensure that the department's biennial budget request
7	to the general assembly includes a sufficient amount for the
8	training, certification, and recertification of district, county,
9	and city service officers.".
10	Page 5, delete lines 19 through 33, begin a new paragraph and
11	insert:
12	"SECTION 6. IC 10-17-12-0.7, AS AMENDED BY P.L.169-2013,
13	SECTION 4, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
14	JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 0.7. (a) The purpose of the fund established in
15	section 8 of this chapter is to provide
16	(1) short term financial assistance, including emergency one (1)
17	time grants, to families of qualified service members for
18	hardships that result from the qualified service members' active
19	duty military service. and
20	(2) funding for:
21	(A) grants for reimbursement for training; and

1 (B) the purchase of computer equipment and software; 2 for county and city veterans' service officers. 3 (b) Funding for the purposes described in subsection (a)(2) must be 4 provided from the amount transferred to the fund under section 13 of 5 this chapter.". 6 Page 6, line 27, strike "The fund may also be used to provide for". 7 Page 6, strike lines 28 through 29. 8 Page 7, delete lines 39 through 42, begin a new paragraph and 9 insert: 10 "SECTION 11. IC 10-17-12-13 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY 11 1,2016]. Sec. 13. (a) The commission shall transfer one hundred eighty 12 thousand dollars (\$180,000) from the veterans' affairs trust fund established by IC 10-17-13-3 to the fund. 13 (b) There is appropriated to the commission one hundred eighty 14 15 thousand dollars (\$180,000) from the fund for: 16 (1) grants for training county and city veterans' service officers 17 under IC 10-17-1-10; and 18 (2) the purchase of computer equipment and software to be used 19 by the city and county veterans' service officers. 20 (c) A county or city veterans' service officer may receive a grant for 21 reimbursement for training expenses associated with service officer 22. training, including travel and incidental expenses of eligible county and 23 city veterans' service officers seeking initial or renewal service officer 24 accreditation. A county or city veterans' service officer may receive a 25 grant under this subsection in an amount not to exceed five hundred 26 dollars (\$500) for reimbursement. The commission shall set standards 27 for the reimbursement grants. A county or city veterans' service officer 28 may apply to the commission for a reimbursement grant, and the 29 commission may make a grant based on the commission's review of an 30 application. 31 (d) A county or city that employs a veterans' service officer may 32 receive a grant, in an amount not to exceed one thousand two hundred 33 dollars (\$1,200), for reimbursement for computer equipment and 34 software to enable the veterans' service officer to access national data 35 bases for benefits for veterans. The commission shall set standards for
