

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 170 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 2, after line 36, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"SECTION 2. IC 35-46-1-8, AS AMENDED BY P.L.158-2013,
3	SECTION 554, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
4	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 8. (a) A person at least eighteen
5	(18) years of age who knowingly or intentionally encourages, aids,
6	induces, or causes a person less than eighteen (18) years of age to
7	commit an act of delinquency (as defined by IC 31-37-1 or IC 31-37-2)
8	commits contributing to delinquency, a Class A misdemeanor.
9	(b) However, the offense described in subsection (a) is:
10	(1) a Level 5 felony if:
11	(A) the person committing the offense is at least twenty-one
12	(21) years of age and knowingly or intentionally furnishes:
13	(i) an alcoholic beverage to a person less than eighteen (18)
14	years of age in violation of IC 7.1-5-7-8 when the person
15	committing the offense knew or reasonably should have
16	known that the person furnished the alcoholic beverage was
17	less than eighteen (18) years of age; or
18	(ii) a controlled substance (as defined in IC 35-48-1-9) or a
19	drug (as defined in IC 9-13-2-49.1) in violation of Indiana
20	law; and
21	(B) the consumption, ingestion, or use of the alcoholic
22	beverage, controlled substance, or drug is the proximate cause
23	of the death of any person; and
24	(2) a Level 6 Level 5 felony if the person committing the offense
25	knowingly or intentionally encourages, aids, induces, or causes a
26	person less than eighteen (18) years of age to commit an act that
27	would be a Level 6 felony if committed by an adult; under any of

1	the following:
2	(A) IC 35-48-4-1.
3	(B) IC 35-48-4-1.1.
4	(C) IC 35-48-4-2.
5	(D) IC 35-48-4-3.
6	(E) IC 35-48-4-4.
7	(F) IC 35-48-4-4.5.
8	(G) IC 35-48-4-4.6.
9	(H) IC 35-48-4-5.
10	(3) a Level 4 felony if the person committing the offense
11	knowingly or intentionally encourages, aids, induces, or
12	causes a person less than eighteen (18) years of age to commit
13	an act that would be a Level 5 felony if committed by an
14	adult;
15	(4) a Level 3 felony if the person committing the offense
16	knowingly or intentionally encourages, aids, induces, or
17	causes a person less than eighteen (18) years of age to commit
18	an act that would be a Level 4 felony if committed by an
19	adult;
20	(5) a Level 2 felony if the person committing the offense
21	knowingly or intentionally encourages, aids, induces, or
22	causes a person less than eighteen (18) years of age to commit
23	an act that would be a Level 3 felony if committed by an
24	adult;
25	(6) a Level 1 felony if the person committing the offense
26	knowingly or intentionally encourages, aids, induces, or
27	causes a person less than eighteen (18) years of age to commit
28	an act that would be a Level 1 or 2 felony if committed by an
29	adult; or
30	(7) punishable under IC 35-50-2-3(a) (penalty for murder) if
31	the person committing the offense knowingly or intentionally
32	encourages, aids, induces, or causes a person less than
33	eighteen (18) years of age to commit an act that would be
34	murder if committed by an adult.".
35	Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
