I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 247 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 19, delete lines 34 through 42.
2	Delete page 20.
3	Page 21, delete lines 1 through 13, begin a new paragraph and
4	insert:
5	"SECTION 18. IC 32-17-13-7, AS AMENDED BY P.L.6-2010,
6	SECTION 23, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
7	JULY 1, 2018]: Sec. 7. (a) A proceeding under this chapter may not be
8	commenced unless the personal representative of the decedent's estate
9	has received a written demand for the proceeding from the surviving
0	spouse or a surviving child, to the extent that statutory allowances are
1	affected, or a creditor. A proceeding under this chapter may not be
2	commenced unless:
3	(1) the claimant delivers a written demand for the proceeding
4	to:
5	(A) the personal representative of the deceased
6	transferor's estate; and
7	(B) each known nonprobate transferee; and
8	(2) the written demand has been filed in the estate, not later
9	than seven (7) months after the deceased transferor's death.
0.	(b) The written demand must include the following information:
21	(1) The cause number of the deceased transferor's estate.

(2) A statement of the claimant's interest in the deceased 2 transferor's estate and nonprobate transfers, including the 3 date on which the claimant filed a claim in the deceased 4 transferor's estate. 5 (3) A copy of the claim attached as an exhibit to the written 6 demand. 7 (4) A description of the nonprobate transfer, including: 8 (A) a description of the transferred asset, as the asset 9 would be described under IC 29-1-12-1, regardless of 10 whether the asset is part of the decedent's probate estate, subject to the redaction requirements of the Indiana 12 administrative rules, established by the Indiana supreme 13 court: 14 (B) a description or copy of the instrument by which the 15 deceased transferor established the nonprobate transfer, 16 subject to the redaction requirements of the Indiana 17 administrative rules, established by the Indiana supreme 18 court; and 19 (C) the name and mailing address of each nonprobate 20 transferee known by the claimant. 21 (c) A proceeding under this chapter may not be commenced on 22 behalf of a claimant, if the claimant has not filed a claim in the 23 deceased transferor's estate by not later than nine (9) months after 24 the deceased transferor's death. 25 (d) A proceeding under this chapter may not be commenced on 26 behalf of a claimant who has not delivered and filed the written 27 demand under subsection (a) by the later of the following dates: 28 (1) Thirty (30) days after the final allowance of the claimant's 29 claim. 30 (2) Nine (9) months after the deceased transferor's death. 31 (e) A proceeding under this chapter may not be commenced on 32 behalf of a claimant if the personal representative has neither 33 allowed nor disallowed the claimant's claim within the deadlines in 34 IC 29-1-14-10(a) and IC 29-1-14-10(b), unless the claimant's 35 petition to set the claim for trial in the probate court under 36 IC 29-1-14-10(a) has been filed within thirty (30) days after the 37 expiration of the deadlines applicable to the claimant's claim under 38 IC 29-1-14-10(a) and IC 29-1-14-10(b). 39 (b) (f) If the personal representative declines or fails to commence 40 a proceeding under this chapter within sixty (60) thirty (30) days 41 after receiving the written demand required under subsection (a), a 42 person making the demand may commence the proceeding in the name 43 of the decedent's deceased transferor's estate at the expense of the
