MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1114 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 4, line 20, delete "without authorization," and insert "having
2	been denied entry by a law enforcement officer,".
3	Page 4, line 21, delete "that:" and insert "that is marked off with
4	barrier tape or other physical barriers,".
5	Page 4, delete lines 22 through 28.
6	Page 4, line 30, delete "(c)." and insert "(c) or (h).".
7	Page 5, after line 38, begin a new paragraph and insert:
8	"(h) It is a defense to a prosecution under subsection (b) that:
9	(1) the person reasonably believed that the person's:
10	(A) child;
11	(B) grandchild;
12	(C) parent;
13	(D) grandparent; or
14	(E) spouse;
15	was in the marked off area; and
16	(2) the person entered the area out of concern for the
17	well-being of the person's:
18	(A) child;
19	(B) grandchild;
20	(C) parent;
21	(D) grandparent; or
22	(E) spouse:
