## **HOUSE MOTION**

## MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1045 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 5, between lines 25 and 26, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"SECTION 2. IC 21-13-9-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.217-2017,
3	SECTION 143, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
4	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 3. (a) The commission, in
5	coordination with the Marian University College of Osteopathic
6	Medicine, shall administer a student scholarship program to increase
7	the availability of primary care for residents of Indiana by providing
8	incentives to medical students who agree to provide primary care in
9	Indiana immediately after becoming a licensed physician.
10	(b) A scholarship awarded under this chapter must be used to
l 1	provide supplemental support to a medical student enrolled at the
12	Marian University College of Osteopathic Medicine and may not be
13	used to reduce any other financial aid, grant, or scholarship the student
14	may otherwise receive.
15	(c) In awarding a scholarship under this chapter, the
16	commission, in coordination with the Marian University College of
17	Osteopathic Medicine, shall grant priority to socioeconomically
18	disadvantaged applicants.
19	SECTION 3. IC 21-13-9-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
20	AS A <b>NEW</b> SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
21	1, 2022]: (a) Not later than November 1, 2022, and November 1 of

each year thereafter, Marian University shall make a report to the
budget committee describing the steps or measures Marian
University has actively taken, and will proactively take going
forward, to encourage recipients of a scholarship awarded under
this chapter to practice in medically underserved areas in Indiana
and in areas in Indiana where there are health care professiona
shortages.

(b) As part of the report described in subsection (a), Marian University shall also submit to the budget committee information describing how the university has previously ensured, and going forward will proactively ensure, that socioeconomically disadvantaged applicants have been or will be made aware of, and actively encouraged to apply for, a scholarship described under this chapter."
