

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1112 # 5

DIGEST

Reversible subdermal contraceptive. Requires a hospital to ensure that a woman giving birth in the hospital has the option of having a long acting reversible subdermal contraceptive implanted after delivery.

- 1 Page 2, after line 27, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 3. IC 16-21-2-18 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
3 AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JANUARY 1, 2023]: **Sec. 18. (a) Except as provided in subsection**
5 **(b), beginning July 1, 2023, a hospital that:**
6 **(1) is licensed under this article; and**
7 **(2) operates a maternity unit;**
8 **shall ensure that a woman giving birth in the hospital has the**
9 **option of having a long acting reversible subdermal contraceptive**
10 **implanted after delivery and before the woman is discharged.**
11 **(b) A hospital is exempt from the requirements in subsection (a)**
12 **if the hospital notifies the state department in writing that the**
13 **hospital has a faith based objection to the requirement."**
14 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
