

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1112 # 7

DIGEST

Medicaid EMS reimbursement rates. Requires, beginning July 1, 2023, the office of the secretary of family and social services and a managed care organization to reimburse under Medicaid an emergency medical services provider organization that is a Medicaid provider at a rate comparable to the federal Medicare reimbursement rate for the service. Specifies that the new reimbursement rate may not be implemented before July 1, 2023.

1 Page 1, delete lines 9 through 14, begin a new paragraph and insert:

2 **"(b) Beginning July 1, 2023, the office of the secretary shall**
3 **reimburse an emergency medical services provider organization**
4 **for Medicaid covered services to a Medicaid recipient, including:".**

5 Page 2, line 4, after "organization." insert **"However, the**
6 **reimbursement rate specified in this subsection may not be**
7 **implemented by the office of the secretary before July 1, 2023.".**

8 Page 2, delete lines 23 through 28, begin a new paragraph and
9 insert:

10 **"(c) Beginning July 1, 2023, a managed care organization shall**
11 **reimburse an emergency medical services provider organization**
12 **for Medicaid covered services provided to a Medicaid recipient,**
13 **including:".**

14 Page 2, line 35, after "organization." insert **"However, the**
15 **reimbursement rate specified in this subsection may not be**
16 **implemented by the office of the secretary before July 1, 2023.".**
