



# SENATE MOTION

**MADAM PRESIDENT:**

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1112 be amended to read as follows:

- 1           Page 2, after line 34, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2           "SECTION 3. IC 12-15-15-1.2, AS ADDED BY P.L.132-2021,  
3           SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
4           UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 1.2. (a) This section applies only to state fiscal  
5           years beginning after June 30, 2021, and ending before July 1, 2023.  
6           (b) As used in this section, "children's hospital" means:  
7           (1) a freestanding general acute care hospital that:  
8           (A) is designated by the Medicare program as a children's  
9           hospital; or  
10           (B) furnishes inpatient and outpatient health care services to  
11           patients who are predominantly individuals less than nineteen  
12           (19) years of age; or  
13           (2) a facility located within a freestanding general acute care  
14           hospital that:  
15           (A) is designated by the Medicare program as a children's  
16           hospital; or  
17           (B) furnishes inpatient and outpatient health care services to  
18           patients who are predominately individuals less than nineteen  
19           (19) years of age.  
20           (c) This section applies to reimbursement for inpatient Medicaid  
21           services and outpatient Medicaid services provided to a Medicaid  
22           recipient who is less than nineteen (19) years of age at a children's  
23           hospital that is located in a state bordering Indiana. This section does  
24           not apply to reimbursement for non-emergency medical transportation.  
25           (d) Subject to subsection (a), the office shall reimburse a children's  
26           hospital for covered services provided to a Medicaid recipient that is  
27           described in subsection (c) at a rate set by the secretary that is based on

- 1 a reimbursement formula that is:
- 2 (1) comparable to the current federal Medicare reimbursement
- 3 rate for the service provided by the children's hospital; or
- 4 (2) one hundred thirty percent (130%) of the Medicaid
- 5 reimbursement rate for a service that does not have a Medicare
- 6 reimbursement rate.
- 7 (e) Before September 1, 2021, the office shall apply to the United
- 8 States Department of Health and Human Services for any state plan
- 9 amendment or Medicaid waiver necessary to implement and administer
- 10 this section.
- 11 (f) The office may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 necessary for the
- 12 implementation of this section.
- 13 **(g) Not later than September 30, 2022, the office shall complete**
- 14 **a review of methods of calculating outlier payments in a way that**
- 15 **does not negatively impact final reimbursement determined**
- 16 **according to the rate set under subsection (d) as compared to final**
- 17 **reimbursement when calculated as if the rate adjustment was not**
- 18 **required under subsection (d).**
- 19 ~~(g)~~ **(h)** This section expires July 1, 2023.
- 20 SECTION 4. **An emergency is declared for this act."**
- 21 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
