MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1123 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, line 6, strike "Ambulance" and insert "**Emergency Medical**
- 2 **Services**".
- 3 Page 2, line 7, after "Home" insert "**and Hospice**".
- 4 Page 2, line 9, strike "Speech and Hearing" and insert
- 5 "**Speech-Language-Hearing**".
- 6 Page 2, delete line 14.
- 7 Page 2, strike line 17.
- 8 Page 2, line 18, strike "(B)" and insert "**(A)**".
- 9 Page 2, line 20, strike "(C)" and insert "**(B)**".
- 10 Page 2, line 21, strike "(D)" and insert "**(C)**".
- 11 Page 2, strike lines 22 through 25.
- 12 Page 2, between lines 25 and 26, begin a new line double block
- 13 indented and insert:
- 14 "**(D) A representative nominated by AARP Indiana.**
- 15 **(E) A representative nominated by The Arc of Indiana.**
- 16 **(F) A representative nominated by the Indiana Minority**
- 17 **Health Coalition.**
- 18 **(G) A representative nominated by the Indiana Rural**
- 19 **Health Association.**
- 20 **(H) A representative nominated by Mental Health America**
- 21 **of Indiana.**

1 (I) A representative nominated by an Alzheimer's
2 Association chapter that provides service in at least one (1)
3 county in Indiana.

4 (J) A representative nominated by a United Way that
5 provides service in at least one (1) county in Indiana."

6 Page 2, between lines 36 and 37, begin a new line block indented
7 and insert:

8 **"(5) The governor shall rotate the appointment of:**
9 **(A) a member of a chapter described in subdivision (2)(I)**
10 **among the chapters described in subdivision (2)(I); and**
11 **(B) a member of a United Way described in subdivision**
12 **(2)(J) among the United Ways described in subdivision**
13 **(2)(J)."**

14 Page 3, after line 2, begin a new paragraph and insert:

15 "SECTION 2. IC 12-15-33-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
16 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 5. (a) An appointment
17 to the committee is for a four (4) year term, except the representatives
18 of the senate and house of representatives, whose terms coincide with
19 the representative's or senator's respective legislative terms.

20 **(b) Notwithstanding any other law, an individual:**
21 **(1) who was a member of the committee and was appointed**
22 **under section 3 of this chapter before July 1, 2022;**
23 **(2) who on June 30, 2022, had at least one (1) year remaining**
24 **on the member's term; and**
25 **(3) whose position to be appointed on the committee was**
26 **eliminated on July 1, 2022;**
27 **may continue to serve as a member of the committee until the**
28 **member's original term expires. This subsection expires July 1,**
29 **2026.**

30 SECTION 3. IC 12-15-33-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
31 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 6. The following shall
32 serve as ex officio members of the committee:

- 33 (1) The state health commissioner or the commissioner's
34 designee.
- 35 (2) The director of the division of mental health and addiction or
36 the director's designee.
- 37 (3) The administrator of the office.
- 38 **(4) The secretary of family and social services or the**
39 **secretary's designee.**

40 SECTION 4. IC 12-15-33-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
41 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 7. The administrator of
42 the office **and a member of the committee who is annually elected**
43 **at the last meeting of the committee during the previous year shall**
44 **serve as secretary co-chairs of the committee.**

45 SECTION 5. IC 12-15-33-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
46 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 9. The committee shall

- 1 do the following:
- 2 (1) Meet at least four (4) times each year, one (1) time in each
- 3 calendar quarter.
- 4 (2) Hold special meetings that the committee or ~~the secretary a~~
- 5 **co-chair** requests.".
