Learning management system. Removes provisions in the bill. Requires, not later than July 1, 2023, each qualified school to use a web based learning management system. Requires a teacher or other employee of a qualified school, upon request, to allow a parent to review any learning material.

Sec. 3. Nothing in this chapter requires a qualified school to provide information described in section 2 of this chapter in a manner that would constitute an infringement of copyright under the federal Copyright Act, 1017 U.S.C. 101 through 1332.".
