

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1134 # 32

DIGEST

Dual credit courses. Amends the definition of "curricular material" to exclude materials used for a dual enrollment credit. Provides that the dignity and nondiscrimination in education provisions do not apply to any course or instruction qualifying for dual enrollment credit.

- 1 Page 14, delete lines 23 through 27, begin a new paragraph and
2 insert:
3 **"(b) The term does not include:**
4 **(1) an academic test or assessment, scoring keys, or other test**
5 **or assessment data used in administering an academic test or**
6 **assessment that is directly related to measuring a student's**
7 **academic performance in understanding a particular**
8 **curricular subject matter, as prescribed by the department;**
9 **or**
10 **(2) any material that is used for a dual enrollment credit**
11 **under IC 21-43, including, as applicable to earning dual**
12 **credit, the following:**
13 **(A) An advanced placement course.**
14 **(B) A Cambridge International course.**
15 **(C) An international baccalaureate course."**
16 Page 35, between lines 24 and 25, begin a new paragraph and insert:
17 **"(i) This chapter does not apply to any course or instruction**
18 **qualifying for dual enrollment credit under IC 21-43, including, as**
19 **applicable to earning dual credit, the following:**
20 **(A) An advanced placement course.**
21 **(B) A Cambridge International course.**
22 **(C) An international baccalaureate course."**
