MADAM PRESIDENT:

 \boldsymbol{I} \boldsymbol{move} that Engrossed House Bill 1134 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page /, delete lines 3 through /.
2	Page 7, line 8, delete "4." and insert "3.".
3	Page 10, delete lines 40 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
4	insert:
5	"SECTION 11. IC 20-33-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
6	AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
7	JULY 1, 2022]:
8	Chapter 1.5. Dignity and Nondiscrimination in Education
9	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "qualified school" has the
10	meaning set forth in IC 20-26-21-1.
11	Sec. 2. In accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of
12	1964 (42 U.S.C. 2000d et seq.), Title IX of the Education
13	Amendments of 1972, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990
14	(42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.), and guidance and implementing
15	regulations from the United States Department of Education:
16	(1) no student shall, on the grounds of sex, race, color,
17	ethnicity, disability status, gender or sexual orientation, or
18	national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied
19	the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination in any school
20	corporation or qualified school in the state of Indiana; and
21	(2) no administrator, employee, or any other staff of a school
22	corporation or qualified school shall instruct or use
23	curriculum or supplemental learning materials to promote
24	discriminatory conduct that would violate the:
25	(A) federal civil rights laws and regulations; or
26	(B) Constitution of the United States.
27	Sec. 3. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to exclude the
28	teaching, discussion, or analysis of factual history or historical or

1	current injustices committed against any sex, race, disability
2	status, ethnicity, religion, gender or sexual orientation, color, or
3	national origin, including the teaching and discussion of
4	curriculum required under IC 20-30-5-7.".
5	Delete pages 11 through 12.
6	Page 13, delete lines 1 through 24.
7	Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
