

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 117 # 3

DIGEST

Confidential identifying information. Prohibits, after June 30, 2023, the broadcast of a Social Security number by police radio unless the broadcast is encrypted. Specifies that certain information is not public.

- 1 Page 2, line 35, after "crime" insert "**or delinquent act**".
- 2 Page 11, after line 31, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 3. IC 10-10.5-4 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 4 AS A **NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE**
- 5 **JULY 1, 2022]:**
- 6 **Chapter 4. Confidential Identifying Information**
- 7 **Sec. 1. After June 30, 2023, a law enforcement officer, a law**
- 8 **enforcement agency, or an employee of a law enforcement agency**
- 9 **may not broadcast a Social Security number over a police radio**
- 10 **unless the broadcast is encrypted.**
- 11 **Sec. 2. Section 1 of this chapter does not prohibit the broadcast**
- 12 **or disclosure of identifying information other than a Social**
- 13 **Security number to the public by other means, including news**
- 14 **reports, press conferences, silver or Amber alerts, wanted notices,**
- 15 **Internet web site postings, and similar methods specifically**
- 16 **intended to inform the public.**
- 17 SECTION 4. IC 31-39-3-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 18 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 2. **Except for**
- 19 **information listed in IC 5-14-3-4(a)(1) through IC 5-14-3-4(a)(15),**
- 20 the following information contained in records involving allegations of
- 21 delinquency that would be a crime if committed by an adult is
- 22 considered public information:
- 23 (1) The nature of the offense allegedly committed and the
- 24 circumstances immediately surrounding the alleged offense,
- 25 including the time, location, and property involved.
- 26 (2) The identity of any victim.

- 1 (3) A description of the method of apprehension.
- 2 (4) Any instrument of physical force used.
- 3 (5) The identity of any officers assigned to the investigation,
- 4 except for the undercover units.
- 5 (6) The age and sex of any child apprehended or sought for the
- 6 alleged commission of the offense.
- 7 (7) The identity of a child, if the child is apprehended or sought
- 8 for the alleged commission of:
- 9 (A) an offense over which a juvenile court does not have
- 10 jurisdiction under IC 31-30-1-2 and IC 31-30-1-4; or
- 11 (B) an act specified under IC 31-30-3-3."
- 12 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
(Reference is to SB 117 as introduced.)
