

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 124 # 2

DIGEST

Operating a motor vehicle. Specifies that a person operating a vehicle must give reasonable notice before slowing or stopping, turning, or changing lanes. Specifies that filing a petition for specialized driving privileges is not mandatory.

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:
3 "SECTION 1. IC 9-21-8-24 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 24. **(a)** A person may
5 not:
6 (1) slow down or stop a vehicle;
7 (2) turn a vehicle from a direct course upon a highway; or
8 (3) change from one (1) traffic lane to another;
9 unless the movement can be made with reasonable safety.
10 **(b) A reasonable time** before making a movement described in this
11 section, a person shall ~~give~~ **provide notice of the person's intention**
12 **by giving:**
13 **(1)** a clearly audible **horn** signal ~~by sounding the horn~~ if any
14 pedestrian may be affected by the movement; and
15 **(2)** ~~give~~ an appropriate stop or turn signal in the manner provided
16 in sections 27 through 28 of this chapter if any other vehicle may
17 be affected by the movement."
18 Page 2, line 9, strike "must" and insert "**may**".
19 Page 2, line 9, delete "privileges" and insert "privileges. **The**
20 **petition must be filed**".
21 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
