

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 124 # 4

DIGEST

Operating a motor vehicle. Specifies that a person operating a vehicle must give reasonable notice before slowing or stopping, turning, or changing lanes. Removes a provision concerning the presence of "any other vehicle". Specifies that filing a petition for specialized driving privileges is not mandatory. Makes the effective date January 1, 2023.

- 1 Replace the effective date in SECTION 1 with "[EFFECTIVE
2 JANUARY 1, 2023]".
- 3 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
4 paragraph and insert:
- 5 "SECTION 1. IC 9-21-8-24 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
6 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2023]: Sec. 24. **(a)** A person
7 may not:
- 8 (1) slow down or stop a vehicle;
- 9 (2) turn a vehicle from a direct course upon a highway; or
- 10 (3) change from one (1) traffic lane to another;
- 11 unless the movement can be made with reasonable safety.
- 12 **(b) A reasonable time** before making a movement described in this
13 section, a person shall ~~give~~ **provide notice of the person's intention**
14 **by giving:**
- 15 **(1)** a clearly audible **horn** signal ~~by sounding the horn~~ if any
16 pedestrian may be affected by the movement; and
- 17 **(2)** ~~give~~ an appropriate stop or turn signal in the manner provided
18 in sections 27 through 28 of this chapter. ~~if any other vehicle may~~
19 ~~be affected by the movement."~~
- 20 Page 2, line 9, strike "must" and insert "**may**".
- 21 Page 2, line 9, delete "privileges" and insert "privileges. **The**
22 **petition must be filed**".
- 23 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
