MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 246 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, delete lines 14 through 17.
- 2 Page 2, delete lines 1 through 18.
- 3 Page 2, line 33, after "to" insert **"help"**.
- 4 Page 2, line 37, delete "do" and insert **"help defray the cost of"**.
- 5 Page 2, line 38, delete "Defray the cost of automobile" and insert
- 6 **"Automobile"**.
- 7 Page 2, line 40, delete "Provide reimbursement for not" and insert
- 8 **"Not"**.
- 9 Page 2, line 42, delete "youth." and insert **"youth pursuant to**
- 10 **IC 9-24-3-2.5."**
- 11 Page 3, delete lines 1 through 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 12 **"Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "foster youth" refers to an**
- 13 **individual:**
- 14 **(1) at least sixteen (16) years of age;**
- 15 **(2) not more than twenty-three (23) years of age; and**
- 16 **(3) who is:**
- 17 **(A) adjudicated a child in need of services under**
- 18 **IC 31-34-1;**
- 19 **(B) an older youth in a collaborative care program under**
- 20 **IC 31-28-5.8; or**
- 21 **(C) a participant in voluntary older youth services**

1 **provided by a contractor of the department and referred**
 2 **to them by a department employee."**

3 Page 3, line 16, delete "8" and insert "9".

4 Page 3, line 32, delete "who are at least sixteen (16) years of age and
 5 not".

6 Page 3, line 33, delete "more than twenty-three (23) years of age".

7 Page 3, lines 36 and 37, begin a new paragraph and insert:

8 **"Sec. 6. A foster youth is responsible for paying all costs of a**
 9 **policy of automobile insurance issued through the insuring foster**
 10 **youth trust program. A state or local government agency, foster**
 11 **parent, or entity providing services to a foster youth under a**
 12 **contract or at the direction of a state or local government agency**
 13 **shall not be required to pay any costs associated with a policy of**
 14 **automobile insurance issued through the insuring foster youth**
 15 **trust program or supervised driving hours and shall not be liable**
 16 **for any damages that result from the foster youth's operation of an**
 17 **automobile owned and insured by the foster youth."**

18 Page 3, line 37, delete "Sec. 6." and insert "Sec. 7.".

19 Page 3, line 41, delete "Sec. 7." and insert "Sec. 8.".

20 Page 4, line 1, delete "Sec. 8." and insert "Sec. 9.".

21 Page 4, delete lines 6 through 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:

22 **"Sec. 10. The department or the department's designee may:**
 23 **(1) develop evaluation criteria, payment calculation**
 24 **standards, and other policies related to the implementation of**
 25 **this chapter; and**
 26 **(2) adopt and make available to foster youth a method for**
 27 **applying for funding under this chapter.**

28 SECTION 3. IC 31-33-18-6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 29 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
 30 1, 2022]: **Sec. 6. For the purposes of IC 31-26-4.5, the department**
 31 **may certify or acknowledge that an individual qualifies as a foster**
 32 **youth under IC 31-26-4.5-2.**

33 SECTION 4. IC 34-30-2-134.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
 34 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 35 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022]: **Sec. 134.7. IC 31-26-4.5-6 (Concerning**
 36 **the department of child services, and liability of a state or local**

1 **government agency, foster parent, or entity providing services to**
2 **a foster youth for costs and damages associated with an automobile**
3 **insurance policy issued to a foster youth.)".**
