COPA study. Allows, as a part of a certificate of public advantage, the state department of health to enter into an agreement with a nonprofit organization or a postsecondary educational institution to study the impacts of the certificate of public advantage on the community's health metrics and outcomes.

Page 5, between lines 6 and 7, begin a new paragraph and insert:

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2	"SECTION 6. IC 16-21-15-4.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA

4	[EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 4.5. (a) As a part of a
5	certificate of public advantage granted by the state department
6	under this chapter, the state department may enter into an
7	agreement with a nonprofit organization or a postsecondary
8	educational institution to study the impacts of the certificate of
9	public advantage on the community's health metrics and outcomes,
10	including any item included in section 4(b) of this chapter.
11	(b) If a study is entered into under subsection (a) the following
12	requirements must be met:
13	(1) The hospital operating under the certificate of public
14	advantage shall supply data it owns or maintains that is
15	required by the nonprofit organization or a postsecondary
16	educational institution to conduct the study and the data
17	supplied must comply with the requirements under the
18	federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act
19	(HIPAA).
20	(2) The preliminary report must be completed within four (4)
21	years of the certificate of public advantage being granted.
22	(3) A final report must be completed within ten (10) years of
23	the certificate of public advantage being granted.
24	(4) Copies of the preliminary and final report must be
25	distributed to the following:
26	(A) The state department.
27	(B) The general assembly, including members of the

2	health, and human services in an electronic format under
3	IC 5-14-6.
4	(c) Nothing in this section requires the state department to pay
5	for a study.
6	(d) Nothing in this section requires a hospital operating under
7	the certificate of public advantage to supply data that it does not
8	own or maintain for purposes of a study.".
