

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 376 # 3

DIGEST

Authorization of gaming. Provides that unless specifically granted authority by a statute passed by the general assembly, the state lottery commission and Indiana gaming commission shall not, independently or by public private partnership, operate or authorize the use or operation of particular games and sales over the Internet. Specifies certain exceptions.

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:
3 "SECTION 1. IC 4-30-3-20 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
4 AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE**
5 **UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 20. (a) This section does not apply to an**
6 **activity specifically authorized by the following articles:**
7 **(1) IC 4-29 or IC 4-29.5 (tribal gaming and tribal-state**
8 **compact).**
9 **(2) IC 4-31 (pari-mutuel wagering on horse races).**
10 **(3) IC 4-33 (riverboat gambling).**
11 **(4) IC 4-35 (gambling games at racetracks).**
12 **(5) IC 4-38 (sports wagering).**
13 **(b) Unless specifically granted authority by a statute passed by**
14 **the general assembly, the commission and Indiana gaming**
15 **commission shall not, independently or by public private**
16 **partnership, operate or authorize the use or operation of the**
17 **following:**
18 **(1) A lottery game operated through a video lottery terminal.**
19 **(2) A video lottery game.**
20 **(3) A video gaming terminal.**
21 **(4) The sale of lottery tickets over the Internet.**
22 **(5) An interactive game played over the Internet."**
23 Page 2, after line 3, begin a new paragraph and insert:
24 "SECTION 3. **An emergency is declared for this act."**
25 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
