



SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 9 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 3. IC 35-31.5-2-24.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 3 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 4 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022]: **Sec. 24.7. "Backup verification**
- 5 **method", for purposes of IC 35-38-2.7, has the meaning set forth**
- 6 **in IC 35-38-2.7-1."**
- 7 Page 3, between lines 26 and 27, begin a new line block indented
- 8 and insert:
- 9 **"(1) "Backup verification method" means a method of**
- 10 **determining whether a tracked individual is in an approved**
- 11 **location in the event that the tracked individual's monitoring**
- 12 **device loses communication with the monitor. The term may**
- 13 **include making electronic or telephonic contact with an**
- 14 **employer of a tracked individual."**
- 15 Page 3, line 27, delete "(1)" and insert **"(2)"**.
- 16 Page 3, line 34, delete "(2)" and insert **"(3)"**.
- 17 Page 3, line 36, delete "(3)" and insert **"(4)"**.
- 18 Page 4, line 4, delete "(4)" and insert **"(5)"**.
- 19 Page 4, line 6, delete "(5)" and insert **"(6)"**.
- 20 Page 4, line 22, delete "monitor;" and insert **"monitor, and the**
- 21 **monitor is unable to verify the tracked individual's presence at an**
- 22 **approved location by using a backup verification method, if**
- 23 **applicable;"**.
- 24 Page 6, between lines 14 and 15, begin a new line block indented
- 25 and insert:
- 26 **"(6) Specify a backup verification method for a tracked**
- 27 **individual if there is reason to believe that the tracked**

1 **individual's monitoring device may lose communication with**
2 **the monitor at an approved location. However, a supervising**
3 **agency has the discretion to establish a backup verification**
4 **method for any tracked individual regardless of whether the**
5 **supervising agency has reason to believe that the monitoring**
6 **device may lose communication at an approved location."**
