

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1258 # 1

DIGEST

Mobile retail food establishment permits. Removes provisions in the bill requiring a local health department to: (1) establish standards concerning mobile retail food establishments; and (2) prescribe an application form. Requires a local health department to issue a mobile retail food establishment and inspect a mobile retail food establishment in accordance with administrative rules adopted by the Indiana department of health (state department). Changes the maximum amount a local health department may charge for an inspection from \$25 to \$50. Provides that a local health department may not adopt standards concerning mobile retail food establishments that are more stringent than the rules adopted by the state department.

- 1 Page 2, delete lines 24 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
2 insert:
- 3 **"Sec. 4. A local health department shall:**
4 **(1) issue a mobile retail food establishment permit; and**
5 **(2) inspect a mobile retail food establishment;**
6 **in accordance with rules adopted by the state department under**
7 **IC 4-22-2.**
- 8 **(b) A local health department shall do the following:**
9 **(1) Establish an annual fee:**
10 **(A) to be paid with each application for the issuance or**
11 **renewal of a mobile retail food establishment permit; and**
12 **(B) that does not exceed one hundred fifty dollars (\$150).**
13 **(2) Establish an inspection fee:**
14 **(A) to be paid for each inspection of a mobile retail food**
15 **establishment; and**
16 **(B) that does not exceed fifty dollars (\$50)."**
- 17 Page 3, delete line 1.
18 Page 3, between lines 22 and 23, begin a new paragraph and insert:
19 **"Sec. 7. A local health department may not adopt standards**
20 **concerning mobile retail food establishments that are more**
21 **stringent than the rules adopted by the state department under**
22 **IC 4-22-2."**
- 23 Page 3, line 23, delete "Sec. 7." and insert "**Sec. 8.**".
