

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1264 # 13

DIGEST

Voter registration. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles commission (commission) to provide training on certain voter registration topics to an employee who provides an individual with a driver's license or identification card application. Requires the commission to establish a policy or procedure that ensures that an individual is informed, in the individual's primary language, that the individual must be a United States citizen to register to vote.

- 1 Page 3, between lines 24 and 25, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 3. IC 3-7-14-5.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
3 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
4 1, 2024]: **Sec. 5.5. (a) The bureau of motor vehicles commission**
5 **shall provide training on the following topics to an employee who**
6 **provides an individual with a driver's license or identification card**
7 **application under section 9 of this chapter:**
8 **(1) The eligibility requirements described in IC 3-7-13-1.**
9 **(2) Communicating the items described in section 9(a) of this**
10 **chapter to an individual who is unable to read, write, or speak**
11 **the English language.**
12 **(3) Ensuring that an individual who is not eligible to register**
13 **to vote does not receive a voter registration application.**
14 **(b) The bureau of motor vehicles commission shall establish a**
15 **policy or procedure that ensures that an individual described in**
16 **subsection (a) is informed, in the individual's primary language,**
17 **that the individual must be a United States citizen to register to**
18 **vote."**
