

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1302 # 1

DIGEST

Emergency medical services. Provides that the department of homeland security (department) shall require EMS providers to provide information necessary for the department to prepare the report. (Currently, the bill provides that the department may require EMS providers to provide information necessary for the department to prepare the report.) Provides that the department shall prepare the report in consultation with the Indiana emergency medical services commission. Makes changes to dates used to gather and compile information and to prepare the report to the general assembly. Changes the effective dates.
