

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 273 # 6

DIGEST

Reporting. Requires the office of the secretary of family and social services to report certain information to the budget committee on Medicaid reimbursement rates provided for biomarker testing.

- 1 Page 3, between lines 23 and 24, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "**(i) Before November 1, 2025, and before November 1 of each**
3 **year thereafter, the office of the secretary shall report to the**
4 **budget committee on the Medicaid reimbursement rates provided**
5 **for biomarker testing. The report shall include the following**
6 **statewide aggregate information for the state fiscal year 2023 and**
7 **the state fiscal year most recently ended:**
- 8 **(1) The total number of patients who received biomarker**
9 **testing.**
- 10 **(2) The total number of patients who received biomarker**
11 **testing for each biomarker test type.**
- 12 **(3) The total amount of state funding expended for biomarker**
13 **testing.**
- 14 **(4) The ten (10) most common conditions or treatments for**
15 **which biomarker testing was ordered.**
- 16 **(5) As a result of the biomarker testing, how many patients:**
17 **(A) were placed on particular therapies;**
18 **(B) avoided certain treatments; and**
19 **(C) were subject to any other treatment impacts.**
- 20 **(6) Any other information requested by the budget committee.**
- 21 **Each provider that receives state Medicaid funding under this**
22 **section shall provide the information described in subdivisions (1)**
23 **through (6) to the office of the secretary not later than August 1 of**
24 **each year."**
