

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

SB 282 # 19

DIGEST

Firefighter and EMT training. Allows an individual who is at least 16 years of age to enroll in and attend a training program for certification as a Firefighter I, Firefighter II, or emergency medical technician.

- 1 Page 5, between lines 33 and 34, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 6. IC 22-14-2-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
3 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
4 1, 2024]: **Sec. 13. (a) An individual who is at least sixteen (16) years
5 of age may enroll in and attend a training program for certification
6 as a:**
7 **(1) Firefighter I;**
8 **(2) Firefighter II; or**
9 **(3) emergency medical technician.**
10 **(b) This section does not affect the minimum age requirements
11 for:**
12 **(1) employment as a firefighter or emergency medical
13 technician; or**
14 **(2) certification by a national certification agency.**
15 SECTION 7. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024] **(a) The board of
16 firefighting personnel standards and education shall adopt rules
17 under IC 4-22-2 to amend 655 IAC 1-1-1.1 to conform with
18 IC 22-14-2-13, as amended by this act.**
19 **(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2025."**
20 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
