
SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senator Thompson to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 182 by Senator Thompson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 16 and 17 and on page 2 delete lines 1 through 7 and insert the
3 following:

4 **"B.(1) When acting in the course and scope of his official duties, a law**
5 **enforcement agency supervisor shall have the authority to submit an electronic**
6 **or other written request to a provider of commercial mobile services, as defined**
7 **by 47 U.S.C. 332(d), for device location information of a commercial mobile**
8 **service device user if either of the following events has occurred:**

9 **(a) A call for emergency services initiated from the device of the user.**

10 **(b) An emergency situation that involves the risk of death or serious bodily**
11 **harm to the device user.**

12 **(2) Upon receipt of the request, the provider of commercial mobile services shall**
13 **disclose to the law enforcement agency the device location information.**

14 **(3) The law enforcement agency when making the request shall also search the**
15 **National Crime Information Center system and similar databases to identify if**
16 **the device user or the person initiating the call for an emergency situation**
17 **involving the device user has any history of domestic violence or any court order**
18 **restricting contact.**

19 **(4) The information obtained by a law enforcement agency under the provisions**
20 **of this Subsection shall be used solely for the performance of official duties.**

21 **(5) No device location information shall be released by the law enforcement**
22 **agency to a person who has a history of domestic violence, stalking, or court**
23 **order restricting contact with the device user."**

24 AMENDMENT NO. 2

25 On page 2, delete lines 25 through 27 and insert:

26 **"E. No person shall file a report with knowledge of the falsity of the information**
27 **contained therein to a law enforcement agency for the purpose of device**
28 **location information being requested from a provider of commercial mobile**
29 **services. Whoever violates the provisions of this Subsection shall be fined not**
30 **more than five hundred dollars, or imprisoned for not more than six months,**
31 **or both."**
