2 Section 566.206, Lines 12 and 13, by deleting all of said lines
3 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "3. [The crime of] Except as provided in subsection 4 of
5 this section, trafficking for the purposes of slavery,
6 involuntary servitude, peonage, or forced labor is a [class B]
7 felony punishable by a fine, not to exceed two hundred fifty
8 thousand dollars, or imprisonment for a term of years not less
9 than five years and not more than twenty years, or both a fine
10 and imprisonment. If death results from a violation of this
11 section, or if the"; and

12 Further amend said bill, Page 4, Section 566.206, Line 17,
13 by inserting after all of said line the following:

14 "4. If death results from a violation of this section, or
15 if the violation includes kidnapping or an attempt to kidnap,
16 sexual abuse when punishable as a class B felony or an attempt to
17 commit sexual abuse when the sexual abuse attempted is punishable
18 as a class B felony, or an attempt to kill, it shall be
19 punishable by a fine, not to exceed two hundred fifty thousand
20 dollars, or imprisonment for a term of years not less than five
21 years, or life, or both a fine and imprisonment."; and

22 Further amend said bill, Page 4, Section 566.209, Line 9, by
23 deleting all of said line and inserting in lieu thereof the
24 following:

25 "2. [The crime of] Except as provided in subsection 3 of
26 this section, trafficking for the purposes of sexual exploitation
27 is a [class B] felony punishable by a fine, not to exceed two
28 hundred fifty thousand dollars, or imprisonment for a term of

1 years not less than five years and not more than twenty years, or
2 both a fine and imprisonment."; and

3 Further amend said bill, Page 4, Section 566.209, Line 11,
4 by inserting after all of said line the following:

5 "3. If death results from a violation of this section, or
6 if the violation includes kidnapping or an attempt to kidnap,
7 sexual abuse when punishable as a class B felony or an attempt to
8 commit sexual abuse when the sexual abuse attempted is punishable
9 as a class B felony, or an attempt to kill, it shall be
10 punishable by a fine, not to exceed two hundred fifty thousand
11 dollars, or imprisonment for a term of years not less than five
12 years, or life, or both a fine and imprisonment."; and

13 Further amend said bill, Page 5, Section 566.212, Lines 14
14 and 15, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu
15 thereof the following:

16 "3. [The crime of] Sexual trafficking of a child is a
17 [class A] felony punishable by a fine, not to exceed two hundred
18 fifty thousand dollars, or imprisonment for a term of years not
19 less than ten years, or life, or both a fine and imprisonment if
20 the child is under the age of eighteen. If a violation of this
21 section was effected by force, abduction, or coercion,"; and

22 Further amend said title, enacting clause and intersectional
23 references accordingly.
