Brattin Offered By 124 (Cass)

1 Amend HCS HB Bill No. 519, Section 191.310, Page 4, Line 57,  
2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

- 3 "191.334. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as "Chloe's Law".
- 4 2. By January 1, 2012, the department of health and senior services shall, subject to
- 5 appropriations, expand the newborn screening requirements in section 191.331 to include pulse
- 6 oximetry screening prior to discharge of the newborn from the health care facility.
- 7 3. The department of health and senior services may promulgate rules to implement the
- 8 provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010,
- 9 that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it
- 10 complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section
- 11 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the
- 12 general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove
- 13 and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and
- 14 any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2011, shall be invalid and void."; and

16 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
17 accordingly.
