1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1174, Page 4, Section 162.081, Line
2 115, by inserting after all of said line the following:

4 “162.481. 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, all elections of school directors
5 in urban districts shall be held biennially at the same times and places as municipal elections.

6 2. In any urban district which includes all or the major part of a city which first obtained a
7 population of more than seventy-five thousand inhabitants by reason of the 1960 federal decennial
8 census, elections of directors shall be held on municipal election days of even-numbered years.

9 The directors of the prior district shall continue as directors of the urban district until their
10 successors are elected as herein provided. On the first Tuesday in April, 1964, four directors shall
11 be elected, two for terms of two years to succeed the two directors of the prior district who were
12 elected in 1960 and two for terms of six years to succeed the two directors of the prior district
13 who were elected in 1961. The successors of these directors shall be elected for terms of six
14 years. On the first Tuesday in April, 1968, two directors shall be elected for terms to commence
15 on November 5, 1968, and to terminate on the first Tuesday in April, 1974, when their successors
16 shall be elected for terms of six years. No director shall serve more than two consecutive six-year
17 terms after October 13, 1963.

18 3. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 4 and subsection 5 of this section, hereafter
19 when a seven-director district becomes an urban district, the directors of the prior seven-director
20 district shall continue as directors of the urban district until the expiration of the terms for which
21 they were elected and until their successors are elected as provided in this subsection. The first
22 biennial school election for directors shall be held in the urban district at the time provided in
23 subsection 1 which is on the date of or subsequent to the expiration of the terms of the directors of
24 the prior district which are first to expire, and directors shall be elected to succeed the directors of
25 the prior district whose terms have expired. If the terms of two directors only have expired, the
26 directors elected at the first biennial school election in the urban district shall be elected for terms
27 of six years. If the terms of four directors have expired, two directors shall be elected for terms of
28 six years and two shall be elected for terms of four years. At the next succeeding biennial election

1 held in the urban district, successors for the remaining directors of the prior seven-director district
2 shall be elected. If only two directors are to be elected they shall be elected for terms of six years
3 each. If four directors are to be elected, two shall be elected for terms of six years and two shall
4 be elected for terms of two years. After seven directors of the urban district have been elected
5 under this subsection, their successors shall be elected for terms of six years.

6 4. In any school district in any city with a population of one hundred thousand or more
7 inhabitants which is located within a county of the first classification that adjoins no other county
8 of the first classification, or any school district which becomes an urban school district by reason
9 of the 2000 federal decennial census, elections shall be held annually at the same times and places
10 as general municipal elections for all years where one or more terms expire, and the terms shall be
11 for three years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified for all directors elected on
12 and after August 28, 1998.

13 5. In any school district which becomes an urban school district by reason of the 2010
14 federal decennial census, elections shall be held annually at the same times and places as general
15 municipal elections for all years where one or more terms expire, and the terms shall be for three
16 years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified for all directors elected on and after
17 the effective date of this section.” ; and

19 Further amend said bill and page, Section B, Line 2, by inserting after the word “districts” the
20 following:

21 “and because immediate action is necessary to clarify terms for school board members
22 elected in April 2012 school board elections” ; and,

24 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
25 accordingly.
