1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 215, Page 1, Section A, Line 4, by inserting after all
2 of said line the following:

4 "43.518. 1. There is hereby established within the department of public safety a "Criminal Records
5 and Justice Information Advisory Committee" whose purpose is to:
6 (1) Recommend general policies with respect to the philosophy, concept and operational principles of the
7 Missouri criminal history record information system established by sections 43.500 to 43.530, in regard to the
8 collection, processing, storage, dissemination and use of criminal history record information maintained by
9 the central repository;
10 (2) Assess the current state of electronic justice information sharing; and
11 (3) Recommend policies and strategies, including standards and technology, for promoting electronic justice
12 information sharing, and coordinating among the necessary agencies and institutions; and
13 (4) Provide guidance regarding the use of any state or federal funds appropriated for promoting electronic
14 justice information sharing.

15 2. The committee shall be composed of the following officials or their designees: the director of the
16 department of public safety; the director of the department of corrections and human resources; the attorney
17 general; the director of the Missouri office of prosecution services; the president of the Missouri prosecutors
18 association; the president of the Missouri court clerks association; the chief clerk of the Missouri state
19 supreme court; the director of the state courts administrator; the chairman of the state judicial record
20 committee; the chairman of the joint legislative committee on court automation [circuit court budget
21 committee]; the presidents of the Missouri peace officers association; the Missouri sheriffs association; the
22 Missouri police chiefs association or their successor agency; the superintendent of the Missouri highway
23 patrol; the chiefs of police of agencies in jurisdictions with over two hundred thousand population; except
24 that, in any county of the first class having a charter form of government, the chief executive of the county
25 may designate another person in place of the police chief of any countywide police force, to serve on the
26 committee; and, at the discretion of the director of public safety, as many as three other representatives of
27 other criminal justice records systems or law enforcement agencies may be appointed by the director of public
28 safety. The director of the department of public safety will serve as the permanent chairman of this committee.

29 3. The committee shall meet as determined by the director but not less than semiannually to perform
30 its duties. A majority of the appointed members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

31 4. No member of the committee shall receive any state compensation for the performance of duties
32 associated with membership on this committee.

33 5. Official minutes of all committee meetings will be prepared by the director, promptly distributed to
34 all committee members, and filed by the director for a period of at least five years."; and
